NEW BUSINESS

- I. Sharon Leite, Co-President
  - A. Requests
    - i. Russ Owen Track Meet – Sharon Leite explained that each year the Boosters assist with medals, ribbons and team trophies for this great event hosted at Bexley. A discussion followed.
    - ii. Brad Morgan moved we spend \$1300.00 for the Russ Owen Track Meet; Doug McMillan seconded. The motion passed.
  - B. Officers for 2007-08 = we will open the nominations through March and vote on officers in April.
- II. Athletic Director's Report – John Morgan
  - A. Hall of Fame Meeting – Gene and Sally Millard are now ready to pass the torch to someone new. John Morgan is setting up a meeting for those interested.
  - B. Weight Room – The current weight room is crowded and new equipment is needed. Safety issues are rising because of the number of students using the facility. One thought is to switch Wrestling team room with the weight room. School officials have meet and approve the move – 2400 sq. ft. to 3600 sq. ft. It will need new flooring (free weight and circuit area will benefit from the new area). John will be approaching private individuals and the Bexley Education Foundation to try to purchase new equipment and flooring. Specific event to raise money.

- C. Athletic Board – John mentioned that the next meeting is Wednesday, January 24. It meets a few times each year. They are bringing this board back to life to communicate with the Bexley School Board. The weight room will be on the agenda. Additional coaching staff issue will be discussed. Bexley does not have paid coaching assistant positions.
- D. Core Curriculum Changes (informative only) – previously the state required one full year of Physical Education in high school. School boards can now adopt a policy to have band, cheerleading and sports students exempt from the course. The Bexley Board to date will probably “not” adopt this policy.
